## WAVE PETUNIAS

- ❖ Original Wave was an All American Selection winner in 1995. It grows 4-6 inches tall and spreads 3- 4 feet.
- ❖ Easy Wave height is 6-12 inches and spreads 2.5-3 feet. The taller height eliminates the hollow center. It has a more mounded and controlled spreading habit, making it ideal for baskets, planters and landscape. Tolerates heat.
- ❖ Tidal Wave height is 16-20 inches and spread is 2.5 -4 feet. It has been referred to as a hedge type. Plant 24" apart
- ❖ Shock Wave height is 7-10 inches and spread is 2.5-3 feet. Petite, but very abundant blooms. Plant 10-15" apart.
- ❖ Double Wave produces frilly flowers for baskets and containers.

## CASCADING PETUNIAS

- ❖ Famous Series blooms early and stays late. Flowers from the center not ends. 2-2.5 inch blooms. 6-8 inches tall and spreads up to 3 feet.
- ❖ Jamboree Series Grandaflora ...Exceptional branching...Blooms fill center of pot, not just the edges.
- ❖ Whisper Series abundant but smaller blooms ...uniform habit, blooms early. Trails 3 feet to cover basket
- ❖ Fame Series Very early... has a mounding habit which makes it perfect for small pots and baskets.

## SUPERTUNIAS

- ❖ Maintenance free. Very large blossoms that attract butterflies and hummingbirds. Bubblegum and Raspberry Frost are two very popular varieties.
