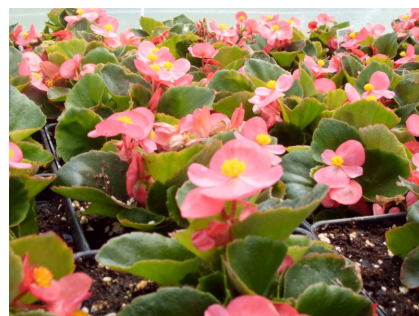




BEGONIA & IMPATIENS

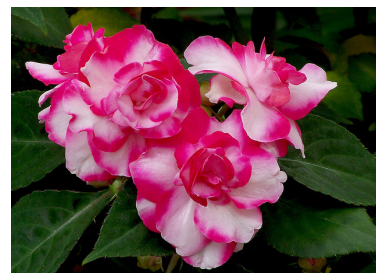
Fibrous Begonia; low growing, low maintenance, plant with good heat tolerance. Frost tender. Blooms well until frost. Six to eight inches tall and spread to eight inches. Prefers shade to filtered sun.



Tuberous begonia; large, showy flowers. Available in both upright and trailing varieties. Most often used in baskets or containers. *Overwatering will cause tuberous begonias to develop root rot.* This is the most common mistake gardeners make with begonias. The soil should be almost dry before they are watered.



Impatiens; good for color in any shady area. Frost tender. Eight to twelve inches tall and spreads to ten inches.



Double impatiens; Blossoms have high pedal count. Looks similar to miniature roses.



New Guinea impatiens; larger blooms in rich colors. More tolerant of sun, but still does well in shade
