Step 1- March/April: T&C Humates Apply 50 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.

Step 2- May/June: T&C Premium Lawn Food. Apply 20 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft. Step 3- July/Aug.: T&C Summer Lawn Food. Apply 20 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft. Step 4- Oct./Nov.: T&C Lawn Winterizer. Apply 20 lbs. per 5,000 sq. ft.

### Step 1 - Town & Country Humates - (March - April)

In the early spring your lawn needs a complete soil fertility builder to help it recover from the rigors of the harsh winter. *Town & Country Humates* contains humates and a wide array micro-nutrients including iron in a totally natural form that not only adds nutrients to the soil, but releases "tied up" nutrients already in the soil so they can be used by the plant. *Town & Country Humates* don't just force-feed the plant, it actually gets to the root of the problem and improves the soil for the long term.

A secondary benefit of using **Town & Country Humates** is the decomposition of thatch in the lawn. The humates speed up the decomposition process that prevents dead grass stems and roots from creating the tight spongy layer that hinders proper absorption of water and nutrients. The result is not only a visibly healthier lawn but also the elimination or reduction of the need to power rake (de-thatch) your lawn.

## Step 2 — Town & Country Premium Lawn Food — (May - June)

In the late spring your lawn needs a boost that will carry it into summer. *Town & Country Premium Lawn Food* contains all the nutrients, including a high percentage of iron, which your grass needs to keep it healthy and give it that deep green color that you want for your lawn. *Town & Country Premium Lawn Food* contains three types of nitrogen, including 60% polymer coated slow-release nitrogen for extended greening of up to 12 weeks. You can't buy a better lawn food. We guarantee it!

## Step 3 — Town & Country Summer Lawn Food — (July - August)

In mid-summer heat your lawn can really stress, the color can dull and your picture-perfect lawn can look a lot less perfect. Don't despair we have a fertilizer to help keep your lawn looking it's BEST even in the heat of summer. **Town & Country Summer Lawn Food** contains a slow-release nitrogen to keep your lawn from looking dull, It has phosphorus to encourage deeper root development which helps with drought stress. We also added potassium and iron to help keep it healthy and green all summer long.

## Step 4 – Town & Country Lawn Winterizer - (October - November)

Late fall is probably the most important feeding of the year. Application can be made anytime in the fall, but the ideal time to apply *Town & Country Lawn Winterizer* is in October or November. Since your lawn is approaching dormancy nearly all of the nutrients are used to promote root growth and very little top growth.

Town & Country Lawn Winterizer contains extra potassium for winter hardiness and 30% slow-release nitrogen. This builds a very dense, healthy turf and provides stored nutrients that will encourage early spring green up, often up to two weeks earlier than lawns that don't receive a fall feeding.

#### **Broadleaf Weed Control**

If you need additional help in controlling dandelions and other broadleaf weeds, spray with *Fertilome Weed-Free Zone* in April or Early May just before the dandelions bloom. Reapply the herbicide in the Fall to kill any weeds you missed in the Spring. Do not spray when the temperature is expected to exceed 85 degrees.

#### **Grub Control**

Lawn insects, particularly Billbugs and White Grubs can destroy large patches of your lawn very quickly. The problem can be prevented with an application of *Grub Free Zone*. The timing is critical! Apply in May, before any damage occurs, for best results. You may need to reapply in early July
